How to find us

From Malaga Direction - AP7

Take exit 133 for A7 towards Torreguadiaro/Estepona/Malaga
At the roundabout, take the 4th exit
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
Turn right onto the ramp to Puerto Sotogrande
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
At the roundabout continue straight
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
Follow to the road for 700m to the Torre de control.

From Malaga Direction – A7

When nearing Sotogrande you will go up and over a hill
At the bottom of the hill there is a roundabout – you will see a car sales garage
At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit
Turn right onto the ramp to Puerto Sotogrande
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
At the roundabout continue straight
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
Follow to the road for 700m to the Torre de control.

From Algecerias Direction

Take exit 1091 for A7 towards Torreguadiaro/Estepona/Malaga
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
Turn right onto the ramp to Puerto Sotogrande
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
At the roundabout continue straight
At the roundabout, take the 1st exit
Follow to the road for 700m to the Torre de control.

Meeting Point

10:00 am outside the Torre de Control, Marina Sotogrande – the directions above will take you to this location.

GPS co-ordinates 36° 17'24'' N - 005° 16'10'' W.

What to bring

1x Passport sized photograph

Sun protection

Sun glasses & hat

Appropriate footwear: deck shoes, non-marking soles, not flip-flops. (Crocs are great!)

Windproof/showerproof jacket/Trousers

Passport/Identification

***PLEASE NOTE: Wet weather gear is not supplied**

Where you will train

Training will take place in and around Puerto Sotogrande marina.

What to expect

Each day is a full day of training covering the safety, handling and navigation of a Motor Boat. You will visit other ports during your course and return to our home port each day.

Course start time on days 2-4 is normally 09:30 and finish around 17:00 (There is will 1 early morning/late night as some “night” navigation needs to take place.

*If you are taking the Yachtmaster Coastal/Yachtmaster Offshore exam, please note that the examiner fees are NOT included in the course price. Current price is £246 which is paid directly to the RYA.
